

## Comeback win

## Hoezee sprints to Bayshore 10K victory

TRAVERSE CITY - Don Hoezee crossed the finish

The 23-year-old Elk Rapids runner "had nothing left" after outkicking Chris Yanni in a sprint finish to win the men's portion of Saturday's Bayshore 10K.

Hoezee, who trailed Yanni by 100 yards halfway through the 6.2-mile race, finished in 31:53. Yanni, a 23-year-old Lake Superior State student, was one second back at 31:54.

Traverse City's John Beach, sixth overall at 34:09, was the top masters finisher.

Ontario's Laura Lynn captured the women's 10K in 36:56 — her best 10K time of the season. She was followed by Traverse City's Lisa Taylor, Bonnie Alanson, Mary Trombley, Kim Andersen, Ann Post and

Owens was the first women's masters runner to finish. Her time: 41:15.

Overall, nearly 500 runners finished the 10K.
The story of the day, however, was Hoezee's dramatic come-from-behind win in the men's race. He caught and passed Yanni in the final 50 yards.
"It was amazing, incredible," said Hoezee. "I still

can't believe what I did.

"I was running with Craig Higby and Donnie Andersen and near the turnaround we were about 100 yards behind Chris. I told those guys I had to make my move right then if I was going to catch him. They said "Go for it." So I went after him. As we neared the college I kept getting closer and closer, and that gave me more and more confidence. To be truthful, though, I still didn't think I could catch him.

"But I kept pushing it, giving it everything I had. I was pushing it so hard I started getting dizzy. At that point (160 yards from the finish) he put a little space between us (five yards). But then I caught my breath again — and I knew he was hurtin' too — so I poured the coals to it one more time on the straightaway and it was just enough. By the time we finished, I had nothing left. I couldn't even stand up.

"Thr really proud of myself for being able to push it that hard, that long. This is one of the best races of my life."

The 11:53 was a personal record for Hoezee, a Grand Rapids native.

Andersen, who finished fourth at 32:51, called Hoezee's effort "remarkable."

"When the three of us were running together and we say the lead to 'Agnib and at the turnaround I made

# Helwig captures marathon

TRAVERSE CITY — Alan Helwig picked up a belated birthday present Saturday.

The Maple City resident, who turned 29 on May 14, received a plaque for capturing the Bayshore Marathon in 2 hours, 35 minutes and 13 seconds — a personal best by nearly four minutes.

Laura Johnson, fourth here a year ago, won the women's marathon in 3:22:21.

Helwig, who works at the Tri-County Health Department, grabbed the lead around the six-mile mark and never relinquished it.

"I was actually running second (to Glen Miller)," said Helwig. "But we both missed a turn at about five or six miles. We had to double back and when we did, well, that's when I took the lead."


Helwig was trailing Miller by 10 yards at the time.

Miller, who finished second at 2:42:40, said the mistake was not a factor in the outcome.

"He would have caught me anyway, probably between six and seven miles," said Miller, who hails from Temperance. "He ran a good race, a tough race."

Helwig had no idea what to expect Saturday.

"You never know who's going to show up for this race," he said. "I ran this back in '83 and there was a guy (Jeff Sharp) who came in here and ran a 2:19.

"I knew Donnie Andersen wasn't going to be in it, but other than that I had no idea what kind of field we'd

have."

Helwig, whose last marathon was in Boston in 1986, decided to run Bayshore in February. He's been averaging 60 to 70 miles per week.

"I felt pretty good coming in," he

said.

Miller, meanwhile, was competing in his fourth marathon of the year.

He's been consistent in all four — running between a 2:42 and 2:46.

"These are the hardest ones to do because you're basically out there by yourself," said the 33-year-old.

Alpena's Wayne Christopherson, 40, was the first masters runner to finish. He was third overall at 2:45:13.

"This is a PR for me," said Christopherson. "It (time) kind of surprises me because I didn't think I do this well. I figured if I ran near 2:50 I'd be doing well. Anything lower than that, I thought, would be a bonus."

Johnson, 23, finished behind Redford Roadrunner teammates Sandi Domagalski, Donna Swanson and Chris Haylett last year. Swanson is Johnson's older sister.

But it was Johnson who was not to

be denied Saturday.

"I've only been running one year and nine months," said Johnson, who has already completed five marathons. "I really thought I was going to break my PR of 3:18 today, but it didn't happen.

"I realized I wasn't going to break it at 10 miles. I accepted it and went from there, just trying to enjoy it."

Johnson, a Westland resident, was third until the 17-mile mark. She took the lead at 19½ miles.

Last year in the Bayshore — her first ever marathon — she finished in 3:42.

"I love this race. I love this course. I love this area," she said, "I wish Westland was more like Traverse City."

Traverse City's Lynne Mixer, 40, won the women's masters class in 3:35:17.

"He's (Yanni) an experienced runner and experienced runners don't vary their pace much. I didn't think there was any way anybody would beat him.

"Don ran one dynamite second half. He was remarkable. What he did, really, was very hard because we hit the turnaround at 15:40, so that meant he ran the second half in just over 15.

"I saw him finish. I was just getting on the (high school) track when they were sprinting. Don has a staggering finish kick. He's really made astonishing progress in the last year. He's tough stuff."

The end result was a "disappointment" to Yanni, who led vir-

tually the entire way.

"I'm happy with my time, but I'm disappointed at how it ended," he said. "I have to hand it to him (Hoezee). He ran a good race. It was a good fight to the finish. I thought I had it. I thought I was going to hold him off."

Yanni's confusion as to the whereabouts of the finish line might

have cost him the race.

"I thought the finish line was back where we started (on College Drive)," he said. "I didn't know it was ending on the track. I was just crusin' in and then when I realized I had to turn on to the track I nearly ran over a couple people getting over there."

Central Lake's Higby came in third at 32:33. Andersen took fourth while Traverse City's Dennis Paull was fifth at 33:26.

The women's 10K wasn't quite as close, but it did feature strong performances by several runners, including Lynn, who turns 39 in two weeks.

Ironically, Lynn's coach had advised her not to run this weekend.

"I had already sent my entry in

when my coach told me that I shouldn't run this race because I have a couple big races coming up in Sudbury and Edmonton," said Lynn. "But when he found out I was coming down here anyway because my husband was in the marathon he agreed to let me use it as a tempo run."

Lynn was coming off a 37:48 10K in Ottawa.

Taylor, 27, finished second to Lynn at 38:18.

"I'm really pleased with that time," she said. "I felt great, especially through four miles. I was at 24:18 at four miles.

"At that point, I felt some tingling in my arms so I backed off a little because that's usually a sign that oxygen is not getting transported the right way. But overall I felt strong. I was hoping to run in the 38s so it's always nice to hit your goal."

Alanson, who was hoping to run around 39:20, came in at 40 seconds

under that.

"Better than expected," she smiled afterwards.

Alanson said she knew she was having a good run because she was able to keep Taylor within sight.

"I knew Lisa was shooting for the 38s, so I figured as long as I could still see her I was doing alright," said Alanson. "I thought I ran at a good, steady pace. This is a good way to start the season."

Mary Trombley, who missed last season with a torn hamstring, finished fourth at 39:33.

"I finally broke the 40 (minute) barrier — again," she laughed.

Two years ago, before her injury, Trombley ran a 37:59.

Andersen, 31, had her "best run ever" at 39:42.

"I had never broken 40 before so this is exciting," she said.

Her time was almost two minutes faster than a year ago. It was seven seconds faster than her goal of 39:50.
